Pre Qualification criteria: Tender documents will be sold only to those bidders who give the following undertakings :

a) that they fulfil the terms and conditions of NIT including the following pre-qualification criteria and

b) that they will submit documentary evidence in support of their above claim along with their techno-commercial (unpriced) bid.

Pre-Qualification Criteria

1.0 Eligibility and Experience of the Bidder

1.1(a)

For Group A

The bidder should have minimum (05) years of experience in providing similar services. Bidder should have executed at least ONE contract of similar nature in the last (05) years (period reckoned from the date of techno-commercial bid opening) and should submit documentary evidence to this effect in the form of satisfactory completion of services from reputed clients.

For Group B

The bidder should have minimum (05) years of experience in providing similar services. Bidder should have executed at least one contracts of similar nature in the last (05) years(period reckoned from the date of techno-commercial bid opening) and should submit documentary evidence to this effect in the form of satisfactory completion of services from reputed clients

1.1(b) In case the bidder is an Indian company/ Indian

Joint venture company, either the Indian company/ Indian Joint venture company or its technical collaborator/ joint venture partner should meet the criteria laid down at 1.1(a).

1.2 Details of experience and past performance of the bidder and the collaborator (in case of collaboration) or of joint venture partner (in case of a joint venture), on works/ jobs done of similar nature in the past and details of current work in hand and other contractual commitments, indicating areas and clients are to be submitted along with the techno-commercial bid, in support of the experience laid down at para 2.1(a) and 2(b) above.

1.3 In case the bidder is a consortium of companies, the following requirement should be satisfied by the bidder:

a) The leader of the consortium should satisfy the minimum experience requirement as per para 1.1(a) above.

b) The leader of the consortium should confirm unconditional acceptance of full responsibility of executing the ' Scope of work' of this tender. This confirmation should be submitted along with the techno-commercial bid.

c) All the members of the consortium must undertake in their MOU that each party shall be jointly and severally liable to ONGC for any and all obligations and responsibilities arising out of this contract.

1.4 (a) Indian companies/ Joint Venture companies :- Indian bidders whose proposal for technical collaboration/ Joint Venture involves foreign equity participation or payment of royalty and / or lumpsum for technical know-how and wherever Govt. approval is necessary, are required to submit copy of Govt. approval, on their application submitted to SIA, prior to the date price bid opening.

1.4 (b) Bidders should submit Memorandum Of Understanding (MOU) / Agreement with their technical collaborator/joint venture partner (in case of Joint venture) clearly indicating their roles under the scope of work.

1.4 (c) MOU/ Agreement concluded by the bidder with technical collaborator/ joint venture partner (in case of joint venture), should also be addressed to ONGC, clearly stating that the MOU /Agreement is applicable to this tender and shall be binding on them for the contract

period. Notwithstanding the MOU/Agreement, the responsibility of completion of job under this contract will be with the bidder.

Other details: Note

1) Bidders will have the option of purchasing tender documents from the selling centers as per prevailing practice or downloading the tender document within the time specified for the sale of tender documents and use the same for participating in the tender. But, the bidders downloading the tender document from the website should ensure to submit tender fee so as to reach the tender inviting work centre before the deadline specified for tender sale along with confirmation on pre-qualification criteria(PQC), which will be acknowledged by ONGC by issuing Request for Quotation (RFQ) number specific to the tender and bidder through Fax/e-mail.

Bidders, downloading the tender document for participation in the tender, will have to prepare and sign the Integrity Pact first and then submit the original document along with the offer (which will be signed subsequently by ONGC's official)
